# CLASS PACKAGES

**GOLD PACKAGE:** For those shows allocated HOYS Qualifiers.

**SILVER or SILVER PLUS PACKAGE:** County or Agricultural 'A' Level shows.

**BRONZE or BRONZE PLUS PACKAGE:** Riding Club or Local 'B' Level shows.

The packages state a minimum number of classes you may hold; however, at your own discretion you may hold upwards of this number and where the Bronze/Bronze Plus and Silver/Silver Plus Packages are concerned it is possible to hold classes taken from the two sections to attain the minimum number (or more classes).

**N.B.** Wherever possible, we would like to encourage ALL Shows to offer Lead Rein/First Ridden, Veteran, Sports Horse/Pony, Junior/Intermediate Rider of the Year and Side Saddle Coloured classes – these are all FREE of CHARGE to affiliate to; LR/FR, Veteran, Sports Horse/Pony & Side Saddle Qualifiers may be offered as part of a non-coloured class with the qualification being awarded to the highest placed eligible coloured exhibit. Novice Ridden Qualifiers are also FREE of CHARGE to hold – see Affiliation Guide and Members' Handbook.

A minimum of 5 qualifiers are to be run (Silver Package); however, Silver-Plus Package or a selection of its classes can be run, but either an Open Youngstock class or BOTH Youngstock (Non-Native and Nat/Cob/Trad) classes must be included.

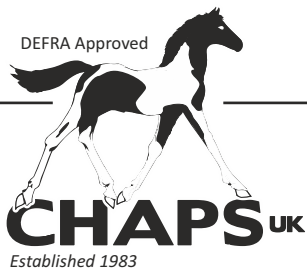

Dear Show Secretary,

Please find enclosed our 2017 Show Affiliation Guide, Forms and Judges Panel List

We are again using the SHOW AFFILIATION NUMBER system and this will be issued upon receipt of completed affiliation form, including Judge Selection and payment. This MUST be quoted on all schedules to enable competitors to complete their Qualification Cards correctly. It is the responsibility of the competitor to have applied for their current Qualifier Card and to get this signed by the judge, in the ring in the two places provided.

If your show is held after the closing date (12<sup>th</sup> August) of the Championship Show then your show will be a 2018 qualifier – please contact the Show Affiliation Secretary for correct wording for your schedule.

May I also draw your attention to the number of free qualifiers we offer:

- Lead Rein/ First Ridden
- Sports Horse/Pony
- Side Saddle
- Veteran

These qualifiers may be taken from within a non-coloured class and do not require a CHAPS Panel Judge and the highest placed CHAPS UK Member/registered exhibit may qualify from rosette placings and again must get their card signed in the ring for qualification to be valid.

The Novice Ridden Horse and Novice Ridden Pony qualifiers are very popular and may also be run as standalone classes and do not carry an affiliation fee. However if you are unable to hold these separately then competitors may get their cards signed from placings within an Open Class.

The following Qualifiers replace the Junior Ridden of the Year and were very well received at our Championship Show with large entries. These can be run as standalone classes or competitors may get their card signed from an open or Novice Class in the appropriate place,

- Junior Rider of the Year
- Intermediate Rider of the Year

If you are holding a County/Agricultural Level Show we ask that you hold a minimum of four classes, especially the ridden section as this helps competitors and judges make their transition to the HOYS Classes.

PLEASE NOTE – a CHAPS UK Panel Judge must be used for the standalone qualifiers to be valid without exception and rulings must be quoted in the schedule, relative to the classes you are running. If you do not comply with these rules then the qualifiers will be invalid. May I also remind you that qualifiers 2.1 – 2.17 MUST be COLOURED ONLY classes, no spotted, duns, roans etc allowed.

Our Spring Journal will be publicised in February and the deadline to have your show included in this edition is 31<sup>ST</sup> JANUARY 2017. Any affiliations received after this date will still be accepted but won't be in this all important edition. All Shows affiliated to us will be advertised on our website.

Don't forget that if you run a Winter show, we also offer Winter Restricted Qualifiers that are aimed at the Novice Exhibits and run from October – March inclusive and are free of charge to affiliate.
