

Ridden Championship 1st and 2nd place eligible

TGCA will have a separate Championship following straight on from this one, Champion will go forward to Best in Show.

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at The East of England Show ground August 2016. Think Pink taking place at Houghton Hall Equestrian Centre The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. These Classes are qualifiers for the traditional gypsy cob Association (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show (TOYS) which will be held at TBC, on the TBC.

These Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. You do not need to be a current member or to have your horse registered with the TGCA in order to take part in these classes.

Qualification will go to the top 3, youngstock, top 3 up to 14hh and top 3 over 14hh, provided the exhibit meets the traditional gypsy cob breed standard (see Stallion exception below).

All exhibits must be registered (passports overstamped) and owners and handlers be fully paid up members either prior to, or within 21 days of the show date. Existing members must present their qualification slip from the judge and will need to join the TGCA and register their horse within the 21 day time frame in order to validate this qualification.

All Stallions (4 years and over) must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show and must display their TGCA stallion disc on their bridle when competing in order to qualify for TOYS. Non licensed stallions may compete in the classes but are not eligible for qualification. All stallions and colts (2 yrs and over) must be bitted when in the ring.

Foals born in the current year are not permitted to be shown in TGCA classes, though they may be shown at TOYS.

Ridden classes. Exhibits must be 4 yrs and over and comply with the above. Additional TOYS qualification is awarded to the highest placed junior rider and the highest placed exhibitor eligible for the restricted category in the class. (I.e. Rider and exhibit NOT to have qualified for HOYS, RIHS, or been placed 1st - 3rd at any county level or in any TOYS finals in the last 24 months). Cards need to be signed, for the categories.

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to

compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 30th August — 1stSeptember 2018. Shows held on or after date of Championship Show will count as 2019 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers [Classes 23 -37]. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings.

All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

<u>In Hand (Additional Rosettes awarded for Best Turned Out)</u> 10am

Class 23 CHAPS (UK) Youngstock Qualifier Any type, height, yearling, two or three year old – no foals.

In Hand Championship – 1st & 2nd from classes 23-28 are eligible to enter. Champion and Reserve Champion In Hand can qualify for the CHAPS (UK)Hamilton Tarmac King of the Ring Final – if either of these have already qualified or are not members/horses registered then the qualifier can be passed down to 2nd Reserve Champion.

Class 35 **The Deanwater Hotel Intermediate Rider of the Year**Open to any type of exhibit up to 158cms. Riders to be 14 yrs or over, up to and including 25 years of age. Two highest placed from Non-Native Section and Native, Cob, Traditional Section will qualify. Class 36 - CHAPS (UK) Ridden Veteran Qualifier
Class 37 Ladies Side Saddle. Any type/height Riders 16yrs and over.

Ridden Championship - 1st & 2nd Place from classes 29 – 37 are eligible to enter.

Champion and Reserve Champion Ridden can qualify for the CHAPS (UK)Rees family King of the Ring Final – if either of these have already qualified or are not members/horses registered then the qualifier can be passed down to $2^{\rm nd}$ Reserve Champion.

Additional notes re Classes 34 & 35 - The Junior Rider of the Year qualifiers and finals section to remain unchanged; the Intermediate Rider of the Year section will be opened up a little as follows - "riders 14 years or over up to and including 25 years. Exhibitors 14 years UPTO 18 years MAY compete in either or both the Junior and/or Intermediate qualifiers, but may not compete the same animal in both sections" At the Finals both the Junior and Intermediate sections will be split into a flat class and a performance class (two jumps) – those who qualify for either the Junior or Intermediate Final may choose to enter either OR both the flat and/or performance Finals as they so wish (for their relevant qualification age)"

BLUE CHIP AMATEUR/HOME PRODUCED RIDDEN/IN-HAND SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

BLUE CHIP Amateur/Home Produced Supreme Championship. All Amateur/Home-produced eligible 1st & 2nd prizewinners from the CHAPS (UK) classes nos 23 - 37. This is a qualifier for the BLUE CHIP Amateur/Home Produced Supreme at the CHAPS Championship Show 2018.

Qualification will be awarded to the highest placed CHAPS Registered exhibit ridden/shown by a CHAPS Member (not already qualified) from the Champion, Reserve or 2nd Reserve from the Blue Chip Amateur/Home Produced Ridden/In-hand Championship. If the qualified exhibit fails to enter for the Preliminary Judging at the CHAPS Champs (by 6th August) they will forfeit their qualification and it will be offered to next highest placed (not already qualified) eligible exhibit.

This will take place at the CHAPS Championship Show, 1st September 2018; where there will be a preliminary judging and the top 6 exhibits will go forward to the Saturday Evening Performance

Amateur/Home Produced is taken as: Produced and exhibited by an individual who does not receive any remuneration from the showing, riding/schooling or production of show horses. Individuals employed in other equestrian areas shall be classified as "Home Produced eligible" for the sake of the CHAPS Home Produced classes/finals/championships. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and may result in disqualification from future classes.

Best in show winners and reserves of Championships in Ring 1 and Ring 2 Eligible

TSE Riders & IN HAND Championships – This show is a qualifier for the 2016 TSR Riders/In Hand Regional Championships. Riders/Handlers can choose which Regional final they go to Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, Wales & South West or Scottish

TSR Riders Champs – 1^{st} & 2^{nd} riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Champs – The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge, cards are available from the TSR website. Full details at http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/ Show Rules
