Rules & Conditions of Entry

Where the term "Members' Handbook" is used it refers to the current CHAPS UK Members' Handbook - plus any relevant subsequent updates.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 17242

1. Both owner and rider/handler need not be a member of CHAPS nor must the horse/pony be registered with CHAPS to compete, but in order to qualify they must both be members and the horse/pony registered with CHAPS BEFORE this show for qualification to be valid (except BSPS qualifiers where Memberships & Registrations, if not already in place, MUST be in place for the Finals for qualification to be valid). The CHAPS UK Championship Show will be held at Arena UK, Grantham - 31st August-3rd September 2017. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS Admin for CHAPS Qualification Card.

2. Please refer to current Members' Handbook (and any updates) for full rulings on all qualifiers.

3. The ruling of the Judges and Officials in FINAL. CHAPS UK reserves the right to substitute judges as required.

4. Full and correct attire must be worn by competitors and their grooms. Hard hats must be worn whilst mounted on any part of the showground. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the Ring. All Junior Exhibitors (under 18 years as at 1st Jan of current year) MUST wear correctly fitting current safety standard hats.

5. The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or alter any class(es) or ring(s) without explanation.

6. All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

7. Neither the Organisers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of this Society accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, handlers, spectators, land or any person/property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

8. CHAPS Judges should refer to the current Members' Handbook to ensure they comply with all categories of exhibit they are not permitted to preside over; and to ensure that the fairest possible results are obtained.

9. No horse or pony under the age of 4 years may be ridden on the showground. No galloping is allowed on the showground except as required by the Judge.

10. Any person participating in any way at this Show who conducts themselves in a manner which might bring the Society into disrepute will be asked to leave the showground and may be subject to disciplinary.

11. All classes will be as listed below unless otherwise stated: IN-HAND classes - 60% conformation, correctness to type and movement and 40% manners and way of going. RIDDEN classes - 50% ride, manners and way of going; 50% type and conformation. JUNIOR RIDDEN qualifiers: (as per Members' Handbook) 60% ride, manners, temperament, suitability and partnership; 40% type and conformation.

12. Exhibitors shall take good care of, and shall not cause any damage or suffer any damage to be done to the site/showground or to any furniture, fittings, equipment or other property therein and shall be responsible to pay for any damage thereto (including accidental damage) caused by any act or neglect in use. This includes stabling.

13. Horse walks must be adhered to. Pedestrians should not walk in the horse walks.

14. All horses/ponies attending are advised to hold current vaccination certificates.

15. No mucking out of lorries/trailers allowed on showground.

16. Any complaint must be made in accordance to regulations within the CHAPS UK Members' Handbook.

17. NO refund of entry fee without a vet's or doctor's certificate; then a 50% refund only is applicable. In the event of cancellation of any Show, refunds will be made less a 25% administration fee.

18. Entry into any CHAPS Regional Show is deemed acceptance to be bound by CHAPS Rules and those of the Show.

19. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

20. Any entries made on show day are accepted in CASH ONLY.

Ring 1 - commencing at 8.30am Judge: Miss L Pickford

Clear Round – To run from 8.30am to 9.00am, rosettes to all clear rounds £3 per go. Not before 9am

Class 1 - Novice Working Performance.

Not to have been placed 1st in any WH/S&P class as a combination as at 1st January of current year. Open to all heights and types. To be jumped in ascending order of height, class may be split if entries warrant

Class 2 - Open Working Performance

Open to all heights and types. To be jumped in descending order of height, class may be split if entries warrant.

PERFORMANCE CHAMPIONSHIP:

1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 1 to 2. Champion & Reserve to compete for Supreme Ridden.

Class 3 - Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier

Any type exhibit, riders 16 years or over.

Class 4 - Lead Rein/First Ridden Qualifier

Lead rein riders 3-8 years inclusive, ponies not to exc 122cms. Snaffle bridle only. Lead rein to be attached to noseband. First ridden riders 10 years and under, ponies not to exc 128cms. Snaffle bridle only. Will be expected to canter in individual shows (First Ridden only).

Class 5 - Ridden or In Hand Veteran Qualifier

Open to horses and ponies of all heights and types aged 15 years and over.

Not before 12.30pm

Class 6 - Ridden 4/5/6 year olds

Open to horses and ponies of all heights and types aged 4, 5 or 6 years.

Class 7 - Granger Show Team Junior Rider of the Year Qualifier.

Open to any type exhibit not exceeding 148cms, riders under 18 yrs
Qualification will be awarded to the 2 highest placed Non-Native or Native, Cob, Traditional.

Class 8 - Granger Show Team Intermediate Rider of the Year Qualifier

Open to any type exhibit not exceeding 158cms Riders over 14 yrs & up to & incl 25yrs, open to all heights and types.

Class 9 - Senior Rider

Riders over 25 yrs, all heights and types. Class may be split if entries warrant.

Class 10 - Amateur/Home-Produced Junior rider

Riders under 18 yrs and under Open to all heights and types

Class 11 - Amateur/Home-Produced Senior rider

Riders 18 yrs or over. Open to all heights and types only

Class 12 - Novice Native, Cob, Traditional Pony Ridden Qualifier

Not exc 148cms. 4 years old and over. Not to have won an Open class before 1st January in the current season (year). To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 13 - Novice Native, Cob, Traditional Horse Ridden Qualifier

Exceeding 148cms. 4 years old and over. Not to have won an Open class before 1st January in the current season (year). To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 14 - Open Native, Cob, Traditional, Show Cob Pony Ridden Qualifier

Not exc 148cms. 4 years old and over

Class 15 - Open Native, Cob, Traditional Horse Ridden Qualifier

Exceeding 148cms 4 years old and over

Not before 12.30pm

Class 16 - Ridden Native Type Horse or Pony Ridden Qualifier

Open to all heights and riders of all ages. Native type only

Class 17 - Ridden Traditional Type Horse or Pony Qualifier

Open to all heights and riders of all ages. Traditional type only

Class 18 - Ridden Cob Type Horse or Pony Qualifier

Open to all heights and riders of all ages. Cob type only

RING 2 CHAMPIONSHIP – 1st & 2nd placed exhibits to compete from classes 12 to 18

Ring 3 - commencing at 9.00am Judge: Mrs A Yates

Class 19 - Novice Non Native Pony Qualifier

Not exc 153cms. 4 years old and over. Not to have won an Open class before 1st January in the current season (year). To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 20 - Novice Non Native Horse Qualifier

Exceeding 153cms. 4 years old and over. Not to have won an Open class before 1st January in the current season (year). To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 21 - Open Non Native Ridden Pony Qualifier

Not exc 153cms. 4 years old and over

Class 22 - Open Non Native Ridden Horse Qualifier

Exceeding 153cms 4 years old and over

Not before 12.30pm

Class 23 - Ridden Hunter/Riding Horse/Hack Qualifier

Open to all heights and riders of all ages. Non Native type only

Class 24 - Ridden Show Pony or Show Hunter Pony Qualifier

Open to all heights and riders of all ages. Non Native type only

Class 25 - Ridden Sports Horse or Pony Qualifier

Open to all heights and riders of all ages. Non Native type only

Class 28 - In hand 3yr old Native, Cob, Traditional pony or horse Qualifier

Class may be split if entries warrant.

Class 29 - In hand 4yr and over old Native, Cob, Traditional pony or horse Qualifier

Class 30 - In hand open to all ages Native, Cob, Traditional pony or horse

Class 31 - In hand Home produced/Amateur Native, Cob, Traditional

Any age horse or pony, open to all handlers

Class 32 - In hand Junior Handler Native, Cob, Traditional

Any age horse or pony, open to handlers 18yrs and under

Class 33 - In hand Best Mare open to all ages Native, Cob, Traditional horse/pony

Class 40 - In hand open to all ages Non Native pony or horse

Class 41 - In hand Home produced/Amateur Non Native

Any age horse or pony, open to all handlers

Class 42 - In hand Junior Handler Non Native

Any age horse or pony, open to handlers 18yrs and under

Class 43 - In hand Best Mare open to all ages Non Native horse/pony
