Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 12th – 15th August. Shows held on or after the Postal Entry closing date of Championship Show will count as 2020 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers [Show Secretary to insert class numbers]. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only Skewbalds/Piebalds may compete these classes. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

Where the term “Members Handbook” is used, this refers to the current CHAPS (UK) Members’ Handbook plus any relevant updates which may have been issued.

1 This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both be Showing Members and the horse/pony must be Registered with the Society BEFORE this show for the qualification to be valid (except BPS qualifiers where Membership and Registration, if not already in place, MUST be made within 14 days of qualification for qualification to be valid). See CHAPS Members' Handbook or www.chapsuk.com for rulings.

2 Entrants in Younstock Evaluations must be registered with CHAPS (UK) and owners CHAPS members.

The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 12-15 August 2020 at Arena (UK), Grantham. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for 2020 CHAPS qualifier card. BPS Winter Championships will be held Arena UK

3 Please refer to Members' Handbook or www.chapsuk.com for full rulings on all qualifiers.

4 The ruling of Judges and Officials is Final. CHAPS (UK) reserves the right to substitute judges.

5 Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. **This includes a hat or cap.** Hard hats must be worn whilst mounted on any part of the Showground. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the Ring. All Junior Exhibitors (under 18 years on 1st January of the current year) MUST wear correctly fitting current safety standard hats.

6 The wearing of ear-rings and body piercings are prohibited as a HSE requirement.

7 The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate class(es) or ring(s) and to alter any class or ring without explanation.

8 No dogs allowed anywhere on the Showground.

9 No litter to be left on the Showground or car parks.

10 Neither the Organisers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of the Society accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

11 No horse/pony under the age of 4 years may be ridden on the showground. No galloping is allowed on the Showground except as required by the Judge.

12 All ages (rider, handler, horse or pony) are taken as at 1st January in the year of competition.

13 Any person participating in any way at this Show who conducts themselves in a manner which might bring the Society into disrepute will be asked to leave the Showground.

14 All classes will be as listed below unless otherwise stated: In-hand Classes will be judged 60% conformation, correctness to type and movement; 40% Manners and way of going. Ridden Classes will be judged 50% ride, manners and way of going; 50% type and conformation. Junior Ridden Qualifiers (as per Members' Handbook) 60% Ride, Manners, Temperament, Suitability & Partnership; 40% Type and Conformation.

15 Exhibitors shall take good care of, and shall not cause any damage or suffer any damage to be done to the site/Showground or to any furniture, fittings, equipment or other property therein and shall be responsible to pay for any damage thereto (including accidental damage) caused by any act or neglect in use. This includes stabling.

16 Horse walks must be adhered to. Pedestrians should not walk in the horse walks.

17 All horses/ponies attending are advised to hold current vaccination certificates.

18 Riders and handlers of colts and stallions must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year, or for stallions under 138cms (13.2hh) to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January of the current year. **All colts over 2 years old must be shown bitted. Younger handlers must apply to CHAPS (UK) for special dispensation prior to the show.**

19 Where stallions are eligible to enter a class, they must be CHAPS Graded. **Stallion discs must be worn** and they must be handled/ridden by a person of correct age, see members' Handbook at www.chapsuk.com.

20 Your signature on the entry form shall be deemed to be acceptance of these Rules and Conditions.

21 No entry will be accepted unless it has been signed.

22 No mucking out of lorries/trailers allowed on Showground.

23 Any complaint must be made in accordance to regulations within the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook.

24 No refund of entries without a vet or doctor's certificate, then a 50% refund only is applicable. In the event of cancellation of the show, refunds will be made less a 25% administration fee.

25 Entry into any CHAPS (UK) Regional Show is deemed to be acceptance to be bound by CHAPS (UK) Rules.

26 Excessive use of whips is forbidden and will result in disqualification. Whips must be of regulation length.

27 Any person participating in any way at this Show who conducts themselves in a manner which may be deemed to bring the Show into disrepute, or who is acting in a way which may be abusive to any animal, person, official, judge or steward will be disqualified from competition and will be escorted off the Showground. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.

28 Fall of a horse/pony in any class requires that the horse/pony is to be lead from the ring. The competitor will be eliminated.

29 No lunging will be allowed on the showground.

30 Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times and are prohibited in Café and viewing area.

31 Push chairs and prams are discouraged near any horse/ponies.

32 Children under 16 must be supervised at all times

**ALL COMPETITORS will be deemed to have read and accepted the following rules as a
condition of entry**

Rules and Conditions of Qualification and Entry

No horse/pony under 4 years of age may be ridden on the Showground. Competitors MUST be a minimum of 3 years of age to ride any horse/pony on the showground. Anyone leading a LR pony must be a minimum of 16 years. Riders in LR /FR classes MUST use a snaffle bridle only.

Any stallions must be ridden/handled by a competent person with a minimum age of 14 years.

Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. All riders must wear correctly fitting headgear to PAS015 (ENS1384 are no longer allowed), or higher, whilst mounted anywhere on the Showground. Junior members are also compelled to wear them when competing in hand. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the ring.

No person who has a conviction (or pending conviction) for animal cruelty will be permitted to compete.

Ages of horse/pony will be 1st of January in the current year.

Spurs are permitted for Senior riders only (aged over 18 years).

Excessive use of whips is forbidden and will result in disqualification. Whips must be of regulation length.

Any person participating in any way at this Show who conducts them selves in a manner which may be deemed to bring the Show into disrepute, or who is acting in a way which may be abusive to any animal, person, official, judge or steward will be disqualified from competition and will be escorted off the Showground. Racial abuse, discrimination, swearing and loud or aggressive conduct will not be tolerated.

Fall of a horse/pony in any class requires that the horse/pony is to be lead from the ring. The competitor will be eliminated.

No late competitors will be allowed into the ring in any ridden class in which the initial trot has commenced: likewise, for in-hand sections, no late competitors will be allowed in the ring after the first horse/pony has begun it's trot out.

Entry fees are non refundable under any circumstances.

The organisers and judges reserve the right to refuse an entry in the event of any unsoundness such as lameness, coughing or dangerous behavior etc

The ruling of Judges/Officials is Final. The organisers reserve the right to substitute judges as necessary.

The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or substitute classes as deemed necessary.

No lunging will be allowed on the showground.

Any person wishing to make a complaint, must do so on the day of the event, within 30 minutes of the alleged complaint, accompanied by £50 administration fee, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

Dogs must be kept on leads & under appropriate control at all times and are prohibited in Café and viewing area.

Push chairs and prams are discouraged near any horse/ponies.

Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.

No persons are allowed in the horse walkways unless they are riding or leading a horse/pony.

Neither the organisers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of the show accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses/ponies, any person, owner, rider, handler, spectator, land or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

Exhibitors shall take good care of, and shall not cause any damage, or suffer any damage to be done to the site /showground or to any furniture, fittings, equipment, stables, or other property therein and shall be responsible to pay for damage thereby (including accidental damage) caused by an act of neglect or in use.

NO Horses to be left tied to horseboxes and trailers on the car park. Under no circumstances must haynets be tied to the side of a horsebox or trailer. Anyone breaking these rules will be disqualified from the competition and asked to leave the showground

Horseboxes and Trailers must not be skipped out onto the showground: please use the muck heaps provided. All rubbish must be taken home or disposed of in the bins provided on the showground: anyone found to have dumped rubbish will be fined £50 clean up fee.

ALL COMPETITORS will be deemed to have read and accepted these rules as a condition of entry
