## Conditions of Entry

### **CHAPS(UK):**

This Show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (uk). Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS(uk) nor must the horse or pony registered with CHAPS(UK) to complete. However in order to qualify both owner and rider/exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid qualification card IN THE RING for signing by the Judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS(UK) for appropriate qualifier card.

The CHAPS(UK) Championship Show will be held on 28<sup>th</sup> August-31<sup>st</sup> August 2019.

All stallions, 4 years and over, entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS(UK). Stallions must wear ID Discs in the Ring without exception.

\*\*The Ridden Champion and Reserve Champion will also qualify for "The Vanguard Properties Holdings" Supreme Ridden Coloured Championship \*\*

### **EQUIFEST QUALIFIERS:**

This Show is affiliated to Equifest to be held at East of England Showground, Peterborough on 29<sup>th</sup> Aug – 1<sup>st</sup> Sept 2019. To gain qualifiers please obtain a qualification card from Equifest to have the judge sign it in the ring. The highest 2(two) exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

**NPS Mountain & Moorland Qualifying Rounds:** These classes will be judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but ONLY ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6<sup>th</sup> Aug – 8<sup>th</sup> Aug 2019.

The highest placed pony, if owned by NPS members, in each class will qualify for the Final. Qualification can pass down to 3rd place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

**In Hand Home Produced Definition:** These classes are open to pure bred ponies registered M&M ponies which are either stabled at home or --in a DIY yard and which since 1<sup>st</sup> Jan in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. To be owned/kept, produced, ridden/handled by a person who does not receive remuneration in cash or kind from working with horses/ponies. No professional producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse/pony.

Please enter this class in the spirit it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.

**M&M Home Produced Ridden Championship-** Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white armband in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

**NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championship:** These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. The Owner's valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the Rosette will be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve pony provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than First Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

**NPS/Kilmannan Stud M&M In hand silver medal championship:** A silver medal rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification. Qualifiers (in Scotland) are entitled to compete in either the NPS/Kilmannan Stud M&M In-Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship in Malvern, or at the Championship Show in Scotland. Qualifiers may only compete in ONE Kilmannan final.

**NPS /Standinghat Stud & Show Team M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship:** A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M ridden section. Qualifiers (in Scotland) are entitled to compete in either the NPS/Standinghat Stud & Show Team M&M Ridden Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship in Malvern, or at the Championship Show in Scotland. Qualifiers may only compete in ONE final.

**NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds:** These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony Section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. **Ponies must be plaited.**

### **NPS Scotland Finals (Blair Castle) Rules 2019**

**TO BE RUN UNDER NPS SCOTLAND FINALS (BLAIR CASTLE) RULES 2019** which are on the NPS Scotland website [www.npsscotland.co.uk](http://www.npsscotland.co.uk) These rules clarify areas particular to NPS Scotland. We also run to the Rules of the NPS and again these can be found on our website.

Exhibitors are deemed to be conversant with these rules.

### **Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials Working Hunter Pony Championship:**

Classes 74-76 are qualifiers. Ponies placed first to third in each class will qualify for the Championship held at Land Rover Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2019. Qualification may go down to sixth place if higher ponies have previously qualified.

### **Botanica/BHS Working Hunter Series ;**

Class 78 is a qualifier

To be eligible for the Final either the Rider or the owner MUST be a member of the British Horse Society.

**FINALS ONLY:** This competition is run under Sports Horse Breeding of Great Britain SHP(GB) the governing body of all hunter and sports horses classes). It is the responsibility of organisers and Competitors to be familiar with these rules; they can be found at <http://www.sporthorsegb.co.uk> **Please be aware of Rule number 48H which states: All ridden hunters must be shod all round. No pads or surgical shoes are allowed.**

### **TGCA In Hand and Ridden Classes: 9-14**

**The classes are open to non members-no known breeding required to enter these classes.**

These classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed small and large sections qualify. **Stallions:** All stallions (4 yrs & over pure or part bred) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class, must have their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the Judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse in order to validate this. Please refer to [www.tgca.co.uk](http://www.tgca.co.uk) for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (Contained within the member's handbook).

**Quest Show:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> from the TGCA classes may go forward for the Quest for a Star Championship, provided they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that Exhibit) MUST be presented upon entry into the Ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championship at TOYS.

**Part bred classes:** The top 3 from the class 11 and 14 will go forward to the "Go for Glory" Championship. Champion & Reserve go forward to the "Crowning Glory" at TOYS which lead to the Supreme Show Part Bred Championship. These exhibits must have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob, a minimum of 50% breeding is accepted.

### **The National Welsh Championship Show Qualifiers:**

This show takes place at Three Counties Showground, Malvern on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2019.

The highest placed Sec A, B, C & D in each Open in hand class will qualify for The National Welsh "Brightwells in hand" Championship and the highest placed Sec A, B, C, & D in each Open Ridden class will qualify for The National Welsh "Brynseion Ridden" Championship. The highest gelding in each of these classes will also qualify for the The National Welsh "Sarum Investments Ltd" Gelding Championship. The two highest placed Welsh A or B in the Open Lead Rein and Open First Ridden Classes will qualify for the National Welsh "Brynseion" Lead Rein/First Ridden Championship respectively. The two highest placed Welsh Part bred will qualify for The National Welsh Ridden "WPBR" Championship. ### **Veteran Horse Society In Hand and Ridden Classes:1-8**

These classes are qualifiers for the Veteran Society Supreme Final. All classes are PRE-QUAL Supreme Final qualifications-there is no 2<sup>nd</sup> rounds. Open to members and non members. However, **only Members may qualify.** Qualification is given to the highest placed VHS member in each category no lower than 3<sup>rd</sup> VHS show registration card is to be produced and handed to the judge in the ring as verification of the qualification. VHS membership to be applied for no later than 1 week prior to this show, to avoid disappointment. ALL competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS rule book 2019 in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification

**Young Rider Championship Qualification:** A Young Rider & Handler qualification will be awarded to the young rider / Handler of the Judge's choice, entitling them to enter the Young Rider/Handler Championship prior to the Supreme Final. This award is given at the judges' discretion. Non members will receive an orange card. Members have to have their cards signed.

### **Festival Scotland 2019 :**

This show is affiliated to Festival Scotland 2019 Championships.

The top 3 not already qualified within the top 6 placings will receive a qualification card. Qualification cards entitle the competitor to enter all classes at both the Scotland and England Summer Championships in 2019. ### **TSR Showing Finals:**

This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR showing finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, South East, Wales & South West or Scottish. You do not have to be a TSR Member to qualify or enter a Final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals.

TSR Finals:1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals: The 2 highest placed handlers with a TSR in hand card will qualify in any in hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the Judge/Steward. Cards are available FREE from the TSR web site.

Open to all Gypsy cobs which are of ANY colour and which meet the TGCA breed standard.

**Class 14: TGCA Part Bred Ridden**

Open to all part breeds. 4 years & over. Any height and sex.

1<sup>st</sup> -3<sup>rd</sup> qualifies for the "Go for Glory" Part bred Championship following on from TGCA Championship.
